

Paper Waste Journey

Recycling paper uses **55%** less water than making paper from virgin pulp and helps to preserve forests.



Place your paper into your blue bin or take it to your local Recycling Centre.



Your paper is then used to make a variety of new paper products, including newsprint.



Your paper is taken to a recycling facility where it is sorted, baled and then sent to a reprocessor. Your paper is then washed, pulped, heated, dried and strengthened.
