

**ROADS (SCOTLAND ACT 1984
ROAD CONSTRUCTION CONSENTS
NOTIFICATION OF INSPECTION CHARGES**

Under the terms of the Road Construction Consent, Council officers will inspect the progress of the roads and associated works as required.

Each inspection will be recorded on an inspection sheet that will detail what has been inspected and whether the works are acceptable or what remedial works are required. The sheet will also record the Council officer who has carried out the inspection and the time involved, which will include travelling time to and from the site as appropriate. The inspection sheet will, where possible, be countersigned by a representative of the developer or their appointed contractor/sub-contractor and a copy will be given to that person for inclusion in the developers records.

Section 140(6) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 entitles the local roads authority to recover expenses reasonably incurred by them to ensure that work carried out complies with the Road Construction Consent. The recovery of these costs will be from the person or company to whom the Road Construction Consent was granted.

West Lothian Council hereby gives notice of its intention to recover those expenses to which it is entitled under the Act.

Details of the rates to be charged are shown in the table below.

Invoices will be issued at six monthly intervals and will cover all of the inspections undertaken during that period and accounts should be settled promptly. Any queries regarding the invoices should be made to any member of the Transportation : Development Planning team.
